

GPS 2024 The "New" Grand Prix Skeet

Dear Shooting Colleagues,

The Wiesbaden Wurftauben Club once again announces its exciting, annual international Grand Prix two day Skeet tournament.

Compared to previous years, we have made a few adjustments to make the competition not only more exciting by adding two additional "Finals", and also more attractive to lower score shooters.

200 skeet targets will be shot by all competitors in the preliminary rounds.

A Class will have a Final competition.

New for this competition is the last three shooters in A and B Classes also have the opportunity to win a special cash prize. To do this, they will compete in a separate 25 Skeet target competition against the first three shooters in the next lower classes, B and C Class.

If at least 42 shooters participate, the total of all prize money and possible bonuses possible is:

€ 7.500

The communal barbecue evening at the end of the first day of competition has become increasingly popular in recent years. All participants, including one accompanying person, are cordially invited to free food and drink.

Conditions of participation

- Participation in the competition is afforded to participants with a valid firearms permit and their own shotgun. This includes members of the Wiesbaden Wurftauben Club. Relevant experience is required to participate. Firearms Safety and proper firearms handling is paramount and a condition of entry. Participation eligability and any associated qualification decisions will be made by the Competition Management.
- 2. Participants born in year 2004 are considered juniors.
- By registering and participating in this tournament, the participant acknowledges their compliance with WTC data protection regulations. - 4. The maximum number of participants is limited to 60.
- 5. The prerequisite for guaranteed participation in the competition is the timely receipt of the participants entry fee at the WTC bank account. Bank account details are provided in the invitation. Should conflicting entries occur, the entry fee receipt timing will decide participation.
- 6. If the maximum number of participants is exceeded, a Waiting List will be created. Waiting List participation in the competition is soley based upon a shooter who is present at the range at 8:30 a.m. on the first day of competition and who is called by competition management to report to the registration office. The shooter order on the Waiting List is determined by the sequence in which registration is received.
- 7. The organizer reserves the option of refunding the transferred entry fee if a shooter voluntarily withdraws.
- 8. The organizer reserves the right to cancel the tournament. In this case, the entry fees that have been paid will be reimbursed. The organizer will not reimburse or cover any additional costs.
- 9. The organizer reserves the right to change the course of the tournament.
- 10. Each participant is responsible for every shot fired and must possess liability insurance coverage. The organizer assumes no liability!
- 11. The conditions stated in the invitation generally apply.
- 12. The published squad divisions including the respective shooting times are binding for shooters. If a shooter is not present at the respective range at the start of a round, they will be subject to ISSF rules.
- 13. The squad assignments during the competition will only be changed after consultation with the shooter. Additional squad assignments will be announced on the second day of the competition
- 14. Protest(s) against a ruling may be lodged with a €100,- fee. Competition management will then form a jury consisting of three experienced shooters to ajudicate the protest. If the protest is unsuccessful the €100,- fee is forfited.
- 15. The organizer decides on the amount of prize money
- 16. Prize money, ammunition and material prizes will be handed out directly after the competition. If the respective prize winner is not present or has not previously named a representative to claim their prize to competition management; their prize is forfited.
